School Review

On Tuesday the School Review Final Day was held. It involved pulling all of the work from previous days and the school's own self-evaluation. The goal and target setting towards the end of the day was most affirming; the school's data is very sound. There were a couple of times that the panel struggled to set an improvement target such was the quality of the current information. Three goals were developed:

Goal 1: To improve Literacy and Numeracy outcomes for all students (F-6),

Goal 2: To improve the engagement of all students through the activation of student voice, agency and leadership and

Goal 3: To continue to develop healthy, happy and resilient students.

Key improvement strategies have been broadly documented for each goal as have improvement targets. We will communicate these to you as we begin to rollout our new Strategic Plan next semester.
