Dear Parents and School Community,

#### **Welcome Back!**

We are thrilled to be back at school. Students have generally settled very well. It feel like the start of a new school year in some ways; students re-acquainting, teachers setting up rooms, routines set up, expectations articulated and social groupings reformed. The difference being, of course that (other than the last two weeks) we have not been on a holiday break. It was a challenging journey over term three and, once again, I am proud of the efforts of students, parents and staff during the remote learning time.

The Department has provided comprehensive advice to schools which we are implementing. They have directed schools to focus on three priorities for students and staff: Mental health and wellbeing, Learning, and Transitions. The Learning priority includes determining the progress of students and their current attainment levels and, where there may be gaps, addressing those areas. The Learning priority also places an emphasis on Literacy and Numeracy with schools adapting their learning program to be responsive to the needs of their students. The Transition priority for our school will be an emphasis on students transitioning to Year 7 as well as young children transitioning to Prep in 2021.

Unfortunately, restrictions in schools still apply including: parents not coming on site, students needing to have their own drink bottle, hand sanitising regimes, enabling air flow in all rooms, encouraging social distancing, wearing face masks unless teaching, determining where and how excursions may take place and making some adaptations in some curriculum areas. We will, of course, strive to make the most of the situation.

Looking forward to a productive term 4.


