Dear Parents and School Community,

Sports Day: Tomorrow is Sports Day! Students are to come to school at the normal time. They will go into their classrooms at 9am and then assemble in the undercover area at 9:20am where they will be placed in their groups for field events (discus, shot put, long jump, high jump, hurdles, vortex throw). With a break in the middle students rotate through the six disciplines. At around 12:50pm there is a lunch break. At 1:30pm we run sprints for all students, 200m races for 9,10,11 and 12 year olds and a relay for selected students from each house. We pack up at about 2:30pm and assemble in the undercover area for the presentation of the House Cup. There is no school assembly this Friday.

Swimming 2019: Our school swimming program will commence next term. The seven sessions will be held at the Ballarat Aquatic and Lifestyle Centre in Gillies Street on Fridays. Please note that there is no swimming in the second week (May 3). The students will go to the pool in two groups: F1S and 56G will swim from 12:30 – 1:15pm, 23R and 34O will swim from 1:15 until 2pm. Permission and medical forms will be sent home on Monday. Please complete all forms and return them to school by Wednesday April 3.
